

A, positive outlook: Fitch confirms Ethias SA's IFS Rating



The rating agency Fitch has confirmed Ethias SA's IFS rating (*Insurer Financial Strength*) at "A, positive outlook".

This continued confidence demonstrates Ethias' financial strength and its good profitability, but also the robustness of its business model, in a turbulent macro-economic and geopolitical context.

Fitch points out, in particular, that Ethias has consolidated its very good capitalization, its solid operational and financial performance, and its very good solvency level. It also highlights its position as a direct insurer on the Belgian market, leader in the public sector.

Non-financial rating by EcoVadis: Ethias strengthens its score and consolidates its Silver Medal



For the second year in a row, Ethias has been assessed by EcoVadis, an international rating agency for corporate sustainability and CSR. The insurer has consolidated its Silver Medal and recorded a 7 % increase in score, placing it among the 17 % of companies with the best performance in this area (all sectors combined). In addition to the numerous environmental and societal actions, EcoVadis also emphasizes transparency in communication and good business ethics.
